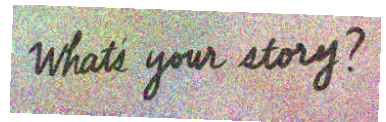
Story Circles with John Genette & Susan Princehouse



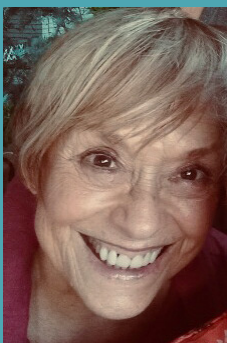
What is a Story Circle? A Story Circle is a community-building exercise: a small group of individuals sitting in a circle, sharing stories from their own experience based on a common theme. Each Story Circle has a facilitator to moderate and engage everyone in the Circle. As each person in turn shares a brief personal story, a larger, richer, communal story emerges. The Circle concludes with a discussion of the common threads between stories and connections made between tellers.
